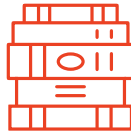


Program Highlight: Capstone Program

Advanced technology, including multi-media podiums, 3D printers and VR headsets



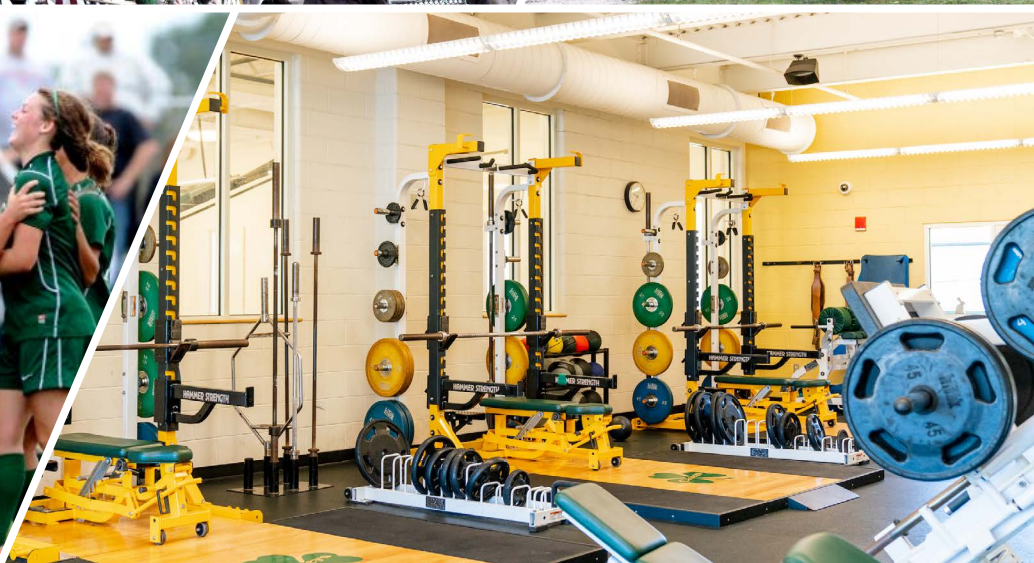
Program Highlight: Engineering Program

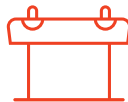

Single-gender, double-occupancy rooms, with 24/7 supervision by Amerigo staff with shared space for socializing, dining, recreation and studying

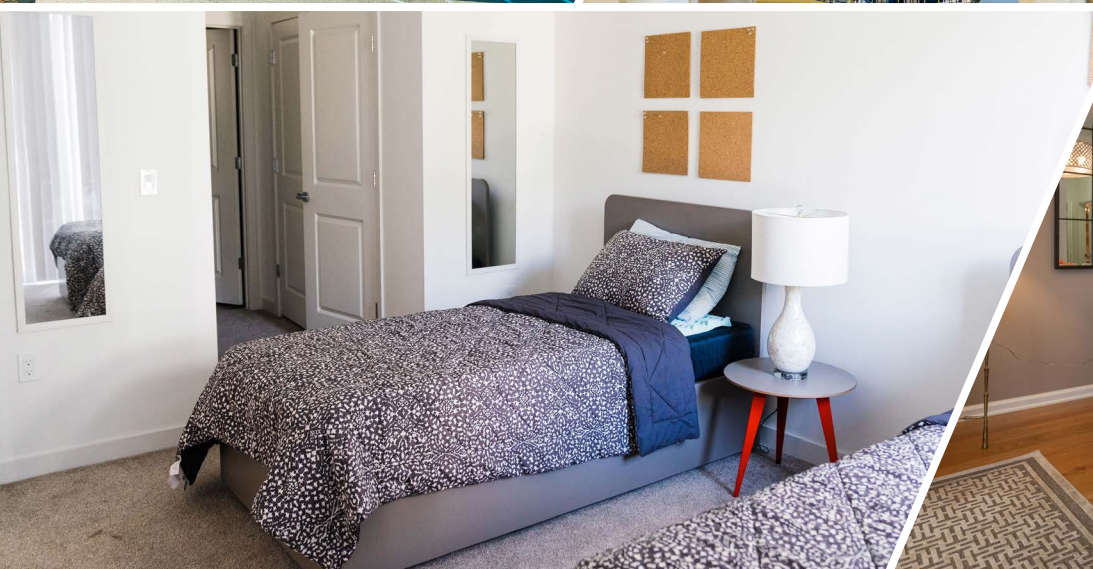
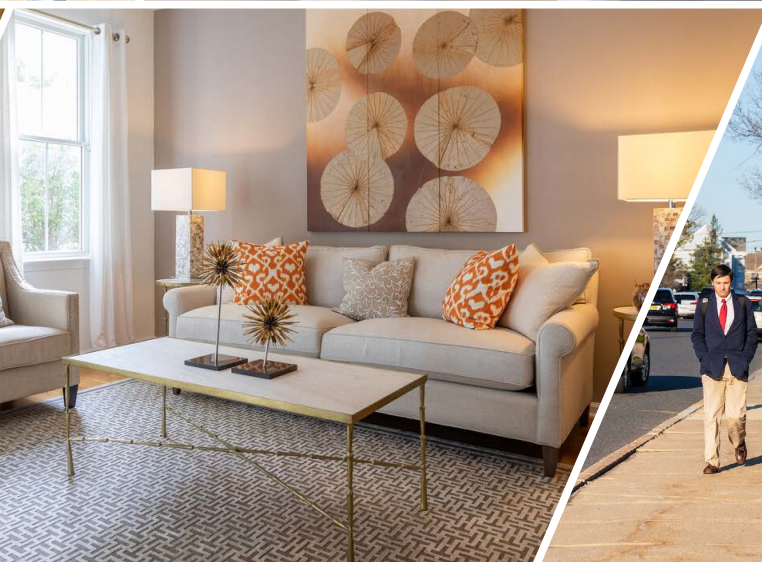

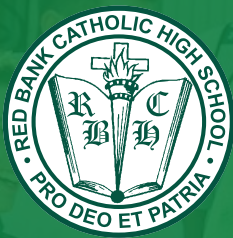
